PENGUIN FACTS

Unlike most
birds, penguins
can drink
seawater thanks
to a special
gland.

Penguins have a
special kind of
camouflage called
countershading. This
means they have black
backs and wings, but
white fronts.
This helps them hide
from predator

Penguins live almost
entirely in the Southern
Hemisphere.
This means they are found
south of the Equator.
All except one- The
Galapagos penguin.

Some
penguins can
leap 2 meters out
of the water and
are excellent
swimmers.

Most penguins eat krill
(tiny shrimp-like
creatures), fish, squid, and
other small sea animals.
They catch their food with
their bills and swallow it
whole while swimming.

Unlike most
birds, penguins
are excellent
swimmers but
they can't fly.
