

Make a Bird Feeder

What You Need:

- Toilet Paper Roll
- Peanut Butter or Honey
- Birdseed
- String
- Butter Knife
- Hole puncher (not essential)



Let's Get Started!

Step 1:

Tie string around the top of the toilet paper roll.

This is how your bird feeder will hang. Make sure the string is tied tightly! Or use a hole puncher and punch two holes through opposite sides of the tube near the top.

Step 2:

Spread peanut butter (or honey) all over the toilet paper roll.

Use a butter knife to evenly coat the entire cardboard roll. This sticky layer will help the birdseed stick.

Step 3:

Roll the peanut butter-covered roll (or honey) in birdseed.

Make sure the entire roll is covered in birdseed. Gently press the seeds into the peanut butter to help them stay in place.

Step 4:

Hang your bird feeder outside and watch the birds enjoy!

Find a good spot in your garden or on a tree branch where you can easily see the birds. Enjoy watching them feast!

Have fun creating your bird feeder and watching the birds! Remember to ask an adult for help with the steps that involve knives or tying the string.

Important: Check the ingredients of your peanut butter to ensure it does not contain Xylitol, which is toxic to birds. Also be aware of any allergies, alternatively, use honey!
